



Dear parents,

The LIA team is happy to welcome your child this school year.

This school year, we have divided the students as following:

Pre 1P to 2P: Ants' class (downstairs) - 3P to 4P: Bees' class (upstairs) 5P to 6P: Crickets' class (Farel room) - 7P to 8P: Dragonflies' class (upstairs)

Mrs Rachel Sanchez is the interim principal with the support of Mrs Farcas, Mrs Hoppe and Mrs Renard as joined leadership team.

Mrs Flavia Farcas is the class teacher for the Ants' class (Pre 1P to 2P)

Mrs Christelle Fomoa is the class teacher for the Bees' class (3P to 4P)

Mrs Rachel Sanchez is the class teacher for the Crickets' class (5P to 6P)

Mrs Sara Hoppe is the class teacher for the Dragonflies' class (7P to 8P)

Mrs Ann-Pascale Valoia, Mrs Lynne Thibodeau and Mrs Corinna Siedler complete the teaching staff.

Mrs Aster Kunz is a teaching assistant. She takes care of the lunch service and the after school club (Club des P'tits Bonheurs).

Mrs Anouchka Luginbuhl coordinates the school communication, helps with the secretarial work, and also takes care of the lunch service.

Please take note of the following points:

- Access for cars to the school campus is exclusively from the «chemin de Bessinge » and vehicles are not
 authorized to park alongside the red and white building. The school parking is located next to the old farm
 (the pink building) and along the access road only. The IBG entrance, route de la Capite, must not be used.
- Please respect the morning drop-off hours from 8:15 to 8:30. Children come into the building straight away. Morning classes finish at 12 noon for the Ants (Pre 1P to 2P) and at 12:10 for the other groups. The students who go home to eat lunch should be back at school between 13:10 and 13:20.
- <u>Classes end at 15:45</u>. We thank you for being on time for school pick-up. Students from 5P and up are allowed to leave the building alone after school.
- Your child can be welcomed in the morning from 7:45 provided that he or she has been registered for this service no later than the day before at 15:45.

The 'P'tits Bonheurs' after-school club is available until 17:45.

As the need arises, you may request regular or occasional use of these services.

Occasional registration is done through the service registration sheets, which are posted on the front door. Please contact the school direction if you are interested in these additional services on a regular basis.

- Concerning the lunch period, the Kidélis services will continue to provide hot meals. The menus are displayed at the entrance. We remind you that if you wish to change your meal option, it is possible to do so no later than the 15th of the previous month for the following month.
- For parents who prepare lunch themselves, the food should be placed in hermetically sealed containers (not glass).

Whenever possible, it is practical for these containers to keep the food at the desired temperature until mealtime.

The entire meal of a single child will be placed in the same bag marked with his name.

- You will find the school calendar in the boomerang book for the Pre1P-2P and in the homework-planner for the 3P to 8P as well as on the LIA website.
- Except in case of an emergency, we would kindly ask that you limit telephone calls to the following hours: Morning from 8:00 till 8:30 At lunchtime from 12:30 to 13:30 In the afternoon, from 16:00.
- Please note that the LIA team will have a day of training on Friday, November 17th, and that school will be closed that day.

Specific points for students in 1P and 2P

In the morning, children are welcomed at the front door of the school. They will also leave using the front door.

Concerning the small recess snack, as a contribution to a balanced diet, **no candies, chips or similar foods or sweet drinks are allowed.** A list of suggested snacks is available at school.

Students should come to school with <u>a small bag</u> marked with his or her name. This bag could contain a small snack for the morning recess and, if needed, a teddy. The snack boxes and teddies should be marked with your child's name.

The children have their own cup at school and can drink as often as they like; no need for other drinks.

Each child has received a "boomerang" notebook, the communication tool between school and home. Students should always have this notebook in their small school bag. We ask parents to check EACH evening the contents of this book and to sign any new piece of information.

We request that each child bring to school in a named plastic bag **a set of spare clothes** (underwear, socks, trousers and T-shirt). This set of clothes will stay at LIA. If your child needs to be changed, we will send home the dirty clothes and ask that you give your child a new spare set of clothes to bring to school the following day.

Please write your child's name on all the clothes and on the bag.

The LIA Team is fully committed to ensure quality teaching while guarantying top safety measures. We thank you for your support and understanding during this school year. We trust it will be an excellent one.
